Flashcard 1: Marmosets are the smallest monkeys in the world. One marmoset can fit in your hand. They live in South America.



Flashcard 2: Mandrills are the biggest monkeys in the world. They are as heavy as a 12-year-old child. They live in the tropical forests of West Africa.



Flashcard 3: Howler monkeys are the loudest of all. They live in tropical forests in Central and South America.



Flashcard 4: Spider monkeys' arms and legs are so long that they remind people of a spider. They live in tropical forests in central and south America.



Flashcard 5: Macaques can live in many different places. They have pouches in their cheeks allowing them to carry extra food.
