
ANIMAL QUIZ



Example for question 1:

- Read the question: No animals can walk on water, true or false?
- Ask groups to discuss the answer they would like to give: true or false.
- Get one person from each group to give you the group's answer and write it down on the board.
- Repeat for all questions.
- Once all the groups' answers are on the board, give out the right answer and keep a record of the teams that have the correct answer.
- When the quiz is over, add up every team's points to find out which team came first, second and third.

True- Rats laugh when they are being tickled but we just can't hear them.

Question 9: Dogs have the best sense of smell out of all the animals.

False- Elephants can smell water up to 4 km away from where they are.



Question 10: All snakes are venomous.

False- there are 3000 different snakes on planet earth and only 600 are venomous.
