## 13 to 16-year olds

- Show learners the pictures of **Stray animals flashcards** provided and engage in the discussion below with them.
- Ask learners how they think these animals survive: Where do they get their food from? Where do they sleep? What happens to them if they are sick or injured?
- Discuss the relationships that they might have amongst themselves, looking at the pictures provided (dogs or cats being affectionate towards one another).
- Ask Learners how people usually react towards stray animals (usually, this is negative).
- Ask learners to produce a poster showing that stray animals are usually harmless and need to be left alone.
