WORLD RABIES DAY QUIZ

- Get learners into teams of 4 to 5 and ask them to answer the 10 questions below. You could ask each group to confer when a question is being asked and to put their hand up once they're ready to give their answer.
- Example for question 1.
 - Read the question: What is rabies?
 - Ask groups to discuss their answer: a) A disease that is passed on via a bacteria b) A disease that is passed on via a virus. c) A way for dogs to show that they're angry.
 - Get one person from each group to give you the group's answer and write it down on the board.
 - Repeat for each question.
 - Once all the groups' answers are on the board, give out the right answer (they are in bold) and keep a record of the teams that have the correct answer.
 - When the quiz is over, add up every team's points to find out which team came first, second and third.

Question 1: What is rabies?

- a. A disease that is passed on via a bacteria

Question 2: What are some of the symptoms of rabies?

- a. Shaking
- b. Running away from the light
- c. Difficulty to swallow
- d. A strong desire to bite



Question 3: Who can get rabies?

- a. Only dogs can get rabies
- b. Only dogs and humans can get rabies
- c. All mammals can get rabies



Question 4: How does rabies spread?

- a. Through contact with saliva
- b. Through the air we breathe
- c. Through contact with blood



Question 5: What is the only solution to prevent rabies from spreading?

- a. Killing all stray dogs
- b. Vaccination
- c. Running away from stray dogs



Question 6: What should you do if you think a dog has rabies?

- a. Throw stones at it to make it go away.
- b. Move slowly and carefully away from the dog and tell an adult.
- c. Approach the dog to try and help it.



Question 7: What should you do if a stray dog comes close to you?

- a. Stand still like a tree, arms by your sides, keep quiet and look at your feet until it goes away.
