1. The largest frog ever found is the African goliath frog. It lived in captivity in Cameroon and weighed the same as a new-born baby!



2. The smallest frog in the world measures 7 mm and can jump up to 30 times the length of its own body.



3. The golden dart frog is the most poisonous frog on earth and the skin of one frog could kill up to 1,000 people.



4. The smelliest species of frog lives in Venezuela, South America. When it feels threatened, it releases the same chemical as skunks, which are the smelliest mammals on earth.



5. Frogs absorb water through their skin so they don't need to drink.



6. Frogs can lay as many as 4,000 eggs in one go.
