Show learners the **flashcards representing Frogs around the world** and for each flashcard, give them the matching facts in your **Teacher's information sheet**.

Show learners the importance of frogs using the flashcards called **Importance and usefulness of frogs**: Full-grown frogs feed on insects, such as moths, grasshoppers, flies, crickets and disease-carrying mosquitoes.



Ask learners to design a poster showing the importance of frogs for humans and encouraging humans to not hurt them.
