

WORLD RHINO DAY

September 22nd

8 to 12-year olds

- ▶▶▶▶ Show your learners the pictures of **Rhinos flashcards** provided so that learners may know exactly what a rhino looks like.
- ▶▶▶▶ Play a game of *Give me that!* A game in which a few learners walk around the class holding a wooden stick (or a ruler) while others have to catch them and confiscate their sticks. Once a learner loses their stick, they are 'dead' and cannot play anymore.
- ▶▶▶▶ When you believe enough learners had an opportunity to play, let the class sit down and focus again. Show them the **flashcard** depicting a **rhino whose horn was stolen** and ask learners why they think they were encouraged to play the game *Give me that!* In their answers, learners should be able to draw parallels between the game and the reality that rhinos face. Ask learners how they feel about rhinos dying of the consequences of their horn being stolen.
- ▶▶▶▶ Ask learners to design posters to draw attention to the rhinos' suffering and to place them around their school community.
