

## Predict the next word

Focus

This activity will help your learners focus on the text you are reading to them while using their logic.

## preparation

- Select a relevant factual text to read out to your class (linked to your learning objective).
- Make sure that you are familiar with the text, and select the key words that you would like your learners to guess within the text.

## procedure

- Let your learners know that you are going to read a text about a particular topic, and that every time you pause, they will have to shout out the word that they think comes up next in the text.
- Start reading the text and pause at the first key word that you selected.
- Let learners call out the missing word before continuing reading;
  and have a short discussion about why the suggested words
  would make sense or not.
- Repeat with the rest of the words you selected.
