

Board game

Reviewing knowledge

This activity will help your learners recall information in a fun way.

preparation

- Print the board game provided on a sheet of paper big enough for up to five learners to play at a time; and print as many copies of the board as needed for your class.
- Make sure you have one dice available per team.
- Feel free to adapt the questions to your own topic.

procedure

- Each player within each team will use a different counter.
- Make sure each team has an answer sheet, as well as the board game itself. One of the team members should be in charge of the answer sheet and check everyone's answers as the game proceeds.
- Each player puts their counter on the space that says 'start'.
- Players take it in turns to roll the dice and move their counter forward the number of spaces shown on the dice. If they answer the corresponding question correctly, they keep their space; if not, they have to go back to their previous position.
- The first player to get to the space that says 'end' is the winner.
