

Feel the shape and guess the animal Just for fun

This activity is great for introducing new animals to your learners as a starter.

It can also be used at the end of a lesson, as a reward.

preparation

- Produce different animal shapes made out of wood, thick card or anything else that can be manipulated.
- Get a blindfold.
- Make sure that you only present the animal shapes to the learner when they are blindfolded.

procedure

- Ask a learner to come to the front of the class.
- Blindfold them and let them feel the shape of an animal. The learner has to work out what animal it is.
- The rest of the class watches them.
- Ask another volunteer to come to the board and repeat.
