3	Donkeys like to eat hay, vegetables, fruit, grasses, bark or leaves
4	Donkey owners are responsible for their donkeys. They are domestic animals and need us to survive. We need to make sure they have enough water, nutritious food, time to rest, and to look after them if they get hurt or are sick.
5	Cows give us milk and meat; they help us plough fields and we use their skin to produce leather. Cows are intelligent animals, and it has been proven that a cow who is looked after and even given a name, produces more milk.
6	A baby donkey is a foal.
7	A baby horse is a foal.
8	Donkeys are used to carry people and things; they work hard in fields, and some people like drinking jennies' milk (jennies are female donkeys).
9	Spiders are useful because they eat insects that feast on our crops such as aphids and caterpillars. They also eat insects that might be in your house.
10	A food chain is a series of organisms (animals, insects, plants) each dependent on the next as a source of food. Example: wheat feeds mice, mice feed snakes, snakes feed birds of prey.
11	Snakes are useful because they can keep rats and mice away. Some species that are harmless to people prey on poisonous snakes, reducing the chance of a deadly encounter. Snakes can also be useful in controlling rat populations.
12	Mice play a very important role in the ecosystem (an ecosystem is the plants and animals that are connected). Mice are food to other animals, keeping a balance in the ecosystem. Mice spread seeds by hiding them and not eating them all, which helps crops develop. Mice provide air in soil by digging, which is very important for the soil to be fertile.
13	A baby goat is called a kid.
14	A baby cat is a kitten
15	If a horse is lame, we first need to check their hooves to see if anything is stuck in it or if they have an abscess caused by infection.
16	We keep donkeys in enclosure at night to avoid accidents on the road or attacks by other animals and theft.
17	Good harnesses are important because they protect donkeys' skin from wounds and excess rubbing. This is more comfortable for them and will avoid wounds getting infected.

18	Yes, donkeys can feel thirsty and hungry, just like you and me. They need regular breaks too.
19	Yes, donkeys need to rest. Carrying heavy loads makes them as tired as you would be if you were carrying heavy loads all day.
20	Yes, donkeys are highly sociable. They like to spend time amongst themselves and even have favourites.
21	If a wound is left untreated, it can get infected, become very painful and prevent your animal from working.
22	To stop cats from having kittens, you need to get them neutered by a vet.
23	The only way to protect dogs from getting rabies is to have them vaccinated. Vets can do this, sometimes for free.
24	Yes, animals can feel scared, just like humans. Animals can feel a lot of the emotions that humans feel.
25	Dogs don't like to be tied up for very long. They like to play on their own or with other dogs. How would you feel if you were tied up all day long?
