



Roll the question

Introducing new knowledge or recalling knowledge

This activity will help your learners answer a question in a fun way, and help them focus on the next activity you choose to suggest.

preparation

- Build a giant dice out of paper (you can use A4 paper, cut up into squares)
- Each number of the dice (one to six) corresponds to a question that you will have prepared on a sheet, related to your lesson objective.

procedure

- Ask your learners to stand in a circle away from their desks.
- Throw the dice on the floor and ask the question related to the number that appears.
- Then ask learners to throw the dice themselves, one at a time and to answer their questions.
- It could get repetitive if you only had six questions so maybe prepare several questions for each number.

Number-related questions:

1. Name a green animal.
2. Name an animal that can jump high.
3. Name an animal that can run fast.
4. Name an animal that can swim in rivers.
5. Name a wild animal that is typically found in your area.

Etc...
