

Remember my words

Using new key words

This activity will help your learners memorise the spelling of key words, as well as memorise them as a list.

preparation

 Prepare a list of the 10 key words you would like your learners to memorise.

procedure

- Write a list of 10 key words on the board and give your learners a minute or two to memorise them. Ask them to pay attention to the spelling too.
- Point to a word and rub it off, then ask learners to write it down from memory.
- Continue until all the words are erased.
- To make this more challenging, erase all the words at once, or erase them three by three.

example

Horse body parts neck 6. hoof 1. 2. chest 7. coronet **3**. barrel 8. muzzle 4. rump 9. front legs hind legs **5**. 10. crest
