



Slam the board

Using new key knowledge

This activity will help your learners memorise and use new information in a fun way.

preparation

- Write information or draw pictures related to the topic you are teaching about, spreading it out as much as possible on the board (it could be a list of animals, a list of animals found in different environments, or a list of different foods for a particular animal.)

procedure

- Call over two volunteers at the board and ask them to keep their hands behind their back.
- Another volunteer from the rest of the class asks a question related to what is on the board. For example:
 - ◇ Find a mammal
 - ◇ What animal lives in the forest?
 - ◇ What do donkeys eat?
- Both learners at the board have to hit the correct answer to the question as fast as possible with their hand.
- The first learner 'slamming' the right answer gets a point.
- Proceed with a different question.
