



# Board race

Introducing new knowledge or recalling knowledge

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This activity will help your learners focus on the lesson topic before you start going into it a bit more deeply.

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## preparation

- None

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## procedure

- Draw a vertical line across the board to divide it into two equal parts.
- Organise some of your learners into two teams of five to ten people, and ask them to line up facing the board.
- Each team will be facing one part of the board.
- The teams get two minutes to write a list of as many items as they can think of as possible, relating to your lesson topic (for example, animals that can be found in their community or what a donkey needs to be happy and healthy).
- Each member of each team can only write one item on the board before passing the chalk to the next person. Only one member of each team is allowed to write at a time. Teams are not allowed to copy each other.
- The team with the most animals at the end of the two minutes wins.
