



Stand up Bingo

Using new key words

This activity will help your learners practise spelling key words and listening out for them.

preparation

- Prepare a list of 20 key words that you would like your learners to focus on.

procedure

- Write your list of 20 key words on the board.
- Get your learners to write down 3 of those words (any 3 they choose).
- Ask your learners to all stand up.
- Call out some of the 20 words, one by one randomly. Cross each word out on the board as you call it out.
- Your learners will need to sit down as soon as any of the words on their list has been called out.
- The aim of the game is for learners to not have any of their words read out, thereby being the last one standing.
