



The four-headed wizard

Reviewing knowledge

This activity will help your learners recall information in a fun way.

preparation

- Prepare a list of questions related to the information that you would like your learners to recall.

procedure

- Ask four learners to come up to the board.
- They stand shoulder to shoulder and are now transformed into a 'wizard' with four heads but one mind.
- Ask a question about your lesson.
- The four learners answer – speaking in turn, and one word at a time.
- Alternatively, you could get the class to ask a question to the wizard, and ask the four-headed wizard to answer the question in unison: the four learners at the board would have to use eye contact to try and confirm what they would all be saying at the same time.

example

- Question: What should you do if your donkey is limping?

We should check for nails or rocks stuck in its hoof.
