Our main curriculum is organised into three different themes:



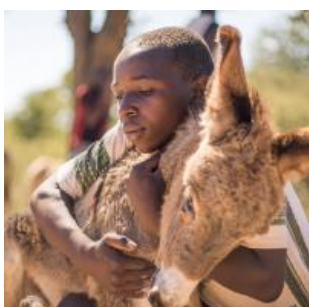
## 1. LESSON PLANS: ALL ABOUT ANIMALS
